Whilst we at Torlundy House cannot guarantee that the eating places listed here will be to your personal taste or budget, they are places in the main that guests give good reports about. There are many other cafes, pubs and hotels in town. This is just a selection of the main ones available.

Please be aware that some establishments take last food orders at 8.30/9.00pm. This may seem early to you, but many people on holiday do turn in early to get a good start in the morning.

The Crannog Seafood Restaurant

01397 705589

Seafood is a specialty here. The restaurant is situated on the side of the dual carriageway that by passes the town centre. Booking often essential and it can be expensive.

The Glen Nevis Restaurant

A good value varied menu, never had a bad report. Lovely views as you dine, situated a couple of miles up Glen Nevis. Both restaurant and bar dining available.

The West End Hotel

Bar and Restaurant meals available. Good value food at reasonable price. Located at the west end of town by the roundabout.

The Loch Iall (at the Premier Inn)

A Brewers Fayre establishment, very good value food and a great menu, good with children, plenty of parking. You don't book a table here, but turn up and check in then have a drink while you wait for a table. Situated behind MacDonald's, near Morrisons.

The Old Station Restaurant at Spean Bridge

The restaurant is located in the old station building at Spean Bridge, great food and friendly atmosphere, bar with local brews. May need booking in the busy season. A favourite of our guests and ourselves.

The Grog and Gruel

In the High Street, good pub with good selection of local and keg beers and good food in the upstairs dining area. Can get very busy in the season.

Café Mango

In the High Street. Indian and Thai food. Many good reports from guests, small so booking may be required.

Browns Restaurant at the Nevis Bank Inn

At the upper end of the price range but very good dining in modern contemporary surroundings. Booking may be advisable. Another favourite of our guests and ourselves.

The Moorings Hotel at Banavie

Hotel with a restaurant, and also does bar meals. Good food, good bar. Take a walk up Neptune's Staircase and watch the boats going through the locks. A favourite of Guests and ourselves.

- Lochleven Seafood Café** 01855 821048
Situated on the road between Onich and Kinlochleven. Very good reputation for seafood. It is some 16 miles away so best to phone and see if a table is available.
- The Alexandra Hotel, The Parade, Fort William** 01397 702241
Hotel that caters for non-residents, often live entertainment in the bar in the evenings in season.
- Ben Nevis Inn, Achintee, Fort William** 01397 701227
Very popular with young people and walkers. A barn conversion, varied menu. It sits on one of the paths to Ben Nevis. Well recommended but needs booking.
- Russell's Bistro at Spean Bridge.** 01397 712335
Booking essential. Excellent food, reflected by the price. Nice intimate atmosphere. Good service. Very popular with tourists and locals alike.
- The Lime Tree** 01397 701806
Booking advised. Good food reflected in the price. Nice modern atmosphere.
- The Stables** 01397 700730
Good food around a grill style. Good reports from guests.
- The Tavern in the High Street** 01397 703600
Good for light meals and snacks in daytime or evening.
- Glen Spean Lodge Hotel** 01397 712223
Located about 12 miles from Torlundy just the other side of Roybridge. Small hotel with good food in the bar, quality of the food is reflected in the price.
- The Old Pines** 01397 712324
Located at Spean Bridge near the Commando Memorial. Booking usually essential.
- The Bridge Café**
Located at Spean Bridge. Good varied café menu at reasonable price. Not open late in the evening but good for lunch and early supper.
- The Crofter**
Busy local pub in the high street. We get reasonable reports of good bar food.
- The Pine Marten at the Nevis Range**
Located at the Nevis Range, next to the Gondola station near the car park. Great café for lunch and snacks, coffee etc.
- Lochaber Farm Shop** 01397 708686
Great lunch and snack menu using local and Fairtrade produce. Locally made gifts and a great farm shop selling local and organic produce as well as some foods for special diets. Find it on the way to the Nevis Range at the Rural Complex.
- Invergarry Hotel** 01809 501206
Our guests report back that the food in the Brasserie is very good, especially the fish and chips. A good choice for an evening meal after a day trip to Skye as you pass right by it.
